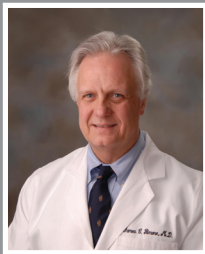
## CARDIOVASCULAR & THORACIC SURGERY
