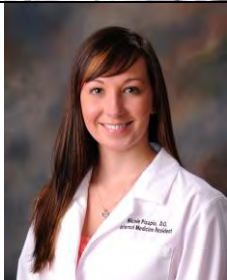

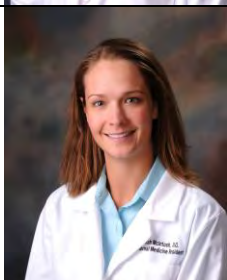
He is a current member of the American Osteopathic Association and American College of Osteopathic Internists. Dr. Rogers enjoys cars, music, photography and water related activities.

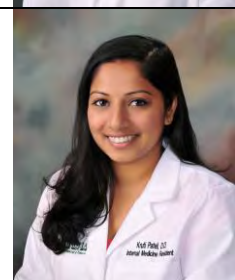
Dasha Cowart, D.O. PGY 2
